Defendant(s): Adrian Gambino, 27, of Milton

Charge(s): Disregarding a police officer's signal, resisting arrest, 2 counts of endangering the welfare of a child, reckless driving, unreasonable speed, limitations overtaking on the left, and speeding.

Victim(s): Society, 4 year old child, and a 1 year old child

Narrative: On March 29, 2013, a Milton Police Officer stopped a vehicle on Cave Neck Road for speeding and passing vehicles in a no passing zone. The Officer approached the vehicle and made contact with the driver, Adrian Gambino. Gambino advised that he was taking one of his passengers to the hospital. The Milton Officer advised Gambino that he would contact an ambulance for the passenger, which Gambino became disorderly and fled from the Officer in his vehicle. The Milton Officer pursued the vehicle southbound on Cave Neck Road, and the vehicle stopped approximately 3 miles down the road. After a brief struggle, Milton Police took Gambino into custody. Milton Police learned that there were three passengers inside the vehicle, a 27 year old female, 4 year old child, and a 1 year old child. Gambino was arraigned and released on \$2,900.00 unsecured bond.



 - *Possession of Marijuana (1 gram)*
 - *Driving while suspended or revoked*

Wilmington, DE- Drug, Organized Crime, and Vice investigators seized 2,599 bags of heroin worth approximately \$34,306.00, after a vehicle stop yesterday evening.

This seizure came at the end of an investigation which led investigators to believe that Michael N. Lopez would be conducting a drug transaction in a center city neighborhood. Lopez, who was driving a grey colored Ford Focus, failed to signal prior to making a turn which subsequently led to a vehicle stop at the intersection of Lancaster and N. Jackson Street. As investigators activated their emergency equipment (lights and sirens), Lopez momentarily stopped his vehicle allowing investigators to do the same. Lopez put his vehicle in reverse striking the investigators vehicle, and then drove forward striking another police vehicle as he attempted to flee. Assisting vice investigators arrived on scene taking Lopez into custody without further incident.

Investigators seized 2,599 bags of heroin, \$874, and one gram of marijuana.

Lopez, who is a probationer, and convicted felon, was committed to Howard R. Young Correctional Institution in lieu of a \$122,000.00 cash bail.
