Featured this year are eight private homes, the Lydia Cannon Museum, Town Hall and St. John's Church all beautifully decorated for the holiday season.

Visitors will enjoy a home with six themed trees and a "Winter Wonderland;" a cozy Craftsman-style cottage; a circa 1828 Colonial with original hardware hand-forged by blacksmiths, original hand-planed woodwork, and a wood burning fireplace in the kitchen; a remodeled mid-century home with vintage ornaments and numerous collections; a church circa 1877 fashioned to suggest an inverted sailing ship's hull; a handcrafted Santa collection; Dickens Village collection; museum built in 1857 with stained glass windows and stamped tin ceiling; Delmarva antiques and artwork collections.

Come and be tempted by the homemade treats and beverages at several locations. The homeowners will be delighted to share information about their homes and cherished decorations. Most of the locations are within walking distance of downtown Milton. The tour will be held rain or shine.
