Narrative: Milton Police responded the 500 block of Union St. in regards to a stabbing in progress. Milton Police arrived & searched the area & located the victim. EMS was called to the scene from staging. The victim had been stabbed multiple times. Milton Police searched the area and H.O. B. Elementary School was placed on lock down for the safety of the students and

staff. Milton Police learned that Majette came to the victim's (ex-girlfriend) place of employment for money. Majette became involved in an argument with the victim then punched the victim on the head knocking her down to the ground. Majette took the victim's purse & ran to the back of a shed on an adjoining property. Majette entered the shed & armed himself with a knife approx. 10" in length & went back to the victim. The victim bleeding from the head attempted to get to safety in the back seat of a vehicle & Majette gained entry into the front seat. Majette then began stabbing the victim multiple times with the knife in the torso & neck area. Majette fled the scene & discarded the weapon. The victim was taken to Beebe Medical Center by Milton EMS where she underwent emergency surgery. Beebe Medical Center heightened security in case Majette arrived looking for the victim. Milton Police with DSP searched the Milton, Ellendale, Lincoln areas for Majette. Majette turned himself into Milton Police at approx. 1630 hrs. Milton Police learned that Majette had been using Heroin during the day & he complained of chest pains & was transported to Milford Memorial Hospital while in Milton Police custody. Majette was treated & released.

Majette was processed @ Milton Police Department & then arraigned with Justice of the Peace Court 3. Majette was committed to SCCI in default of \$107,600.00 cash bond with a No Contact Order pending CCP preliminary hearing. The Victim is recovering at Beebe Medical Center.
