

Town of Milton Water Committee

November 12, 2013

Chairman Emory West called the Town of Milton Water Committee meeting to order in the Milton Library, 121 Union Street at 5:00 P.M.

Roll Call of Members present: Emory West, Dustan Russum, William Woods, Denny Hughes and John Bushey. Sam Garde was not present.

There were two individuals from the public present: V. Vadeska, G. Jones.

Chairman West presented a list of items that we need to review and prioritize for our long range planning to meet the committees' goals and objectives. The committees' goals and objectives is to work within the current income and surplus monies of the water accounts. It is the desire of the committee that we can make capital improvements without borrowing any monies. Example a new well. See attached list.

West wants the committee to brain storm come up with ideas for our next meeting.

Chairman West stated that people within the community do not want an interconnection line with Artesian Water Company. They have concerns that it will go as Tidewater did.

John Bushey pointed out to the Chairman that he needs to call a committee meeting of the land acquisition committee before our next water committee meeting. This needs to be part of our long range planning and it is connected to the wells issues.

Bushey stated he had talked with Council Mike Cote, treasurer who had given him the balances in the Water Checking and Water Impact Fees accounts. Checking \$478,497.82 and Impact Fees \$333,481.84 as of September 30, 2013. Cote further stated that there was approximately \$100,000.00 worth of capital improvements coming up monies to come out of the water checking account. A discussion took place about our water rates.

Bushey informed the committee members that he had talked with an individual who just put in a new well at 550 ft. depth, 750 gallon per minutes at a cost of less than \$150,000.00. This did not include the chloride or fluoride treatment for the water. That the individual have offered to give him a copy of the contract.


A discussion took place about:

1. Cost for repairs of equipment
2. Putting everything down in a step by step process.
3. Monies for projects/planning over several years.
4. Land acquisition
5. Water Towers/Repairs/ need for.....not eminent
6. Mapping/cost/\$25,000.00/
7. Placement of wells for water flow/mapping will help.

- Mapping will help take care of this.
8. Well#5 recommendations from Pennoni, see last months minutes 10/28/13. Keeping well # 5 for emergencies and putting in a new well.
  9. See minutes 10/28/13 Water Ordinance 215-31 Adding hours that water irrigation can be done.
  10. Code Enforcer and Roger Davis were asked by West for their comments.

A motion was made by William Woods and Second by John Bushey to adjourn at 5:40 P.M.
