Crust & Filling (30%)

Ingredients should have a well-balanced, uniform flavor. Filling should be consistent. Crust should have an even thickness across the side and bottom. Together the crust and filling should complement each other.

Overall Flavor (50%)

What makes a good pie? The crust – flaky and melt-inyour-mouth that is baked evenly with a light, golden color. The filling- smooth and uniform components with a pleasant aroma and flavor, appealing color and texture.
