Water Department

The Water Department has been working on upgrades for the pits and meter setters, reading water meters for 4th quarter billing, sample testing and monthly testing done, flushing hydrants, water line locates and inspections. We've had a lot of building in Wagamon's and Heritage that we've had to inspect the water service, locate and staked out water valves. I have talked with Matt (Corrosion Control Corp) about the sandblasting and painting for tower #1(Candler St.) and they should start work on this in January. They will be wrapping the Tower when they sandblast and paint so we don't have a problem with paint chips, sand or over spray. We've spent a lot of time on locates and inspections of new homes in the past month due to the cold weather and the builders trying to complete the homes quickly. We've done inventory of equipment and parts for the water department. We've started rebuilding water meters, valves and pits. We've started the upgrades in the well house with rebuilding pumps, installing pipe and lines.

Streets Department

The Street Department has been busy with cold patching holes in streets, cleaning storm drains, picking up trash off the road, hand sweeping streets and emptying trash receptacles. We've been very busy trying to keep the storm drains cleaned from leaves running down the curb line. We've been cutting out around street boxes to repair and reset the boxes. We've raised four ketch spacing's up on Chestnut Street and repaired two Tops on Yew Street and Sussex Street. We've done an inventory on equipment and parts. We've inspected plows, serviced equipment and have supplies. We've started going over every street to trim limbs, bushes and repairing signs. We've been working on the upgrades on the signs.

Parks

We've spent time keeping limbs, trash and leaves picked up in all the Parks. Inspections done on playground equipment.

We've been very busy in all departments, but I would like to add that we've spent time fixing Christmas Lights all around town and replaced a timer and breaker on the Lights on Federal Street.
