*Intake Process:* Walk in or appointment after going to social services. Assistance with rent, utilities, evictions, emergency shelter, emergency food and medical prescriptions

*Intake Process:* Call or walk ins welcome. Provides goods and services, furniture, clothing, and house wares are sold at reasonable prices. Limited financial assistance available for rent, electric, fuel, and prescriptions.

Delaware State Housing Authority – DEMAP (302) 697-3187

*Intake Process:* Call for more information

DEMAM is a loan that provides Delaware Homeowners with assistance in preventing residential mortgage foreclosures that could result from involuntary reduction of hours or loss of employment due to the economic downturn or the loss of income due to injury or illness. DEMAM assists with monthly mortgage payments for up to 24 months or \$30,000 which ever is first. Call DSHA for more information and for information about other assistance programs that may be available.

The Medicine Program – Free Prescription Medication (573) 996-3333

*Intake Process:* Apply online or call for application

*Assistant to uninsured or underinsured and persons who have maxed out prescription coverage. Free prescription medication available for all ages nationwide to households with income as high as \$80,000.*

*Intake Process:* Contact the Cheer Center directly to join or sign up for services.
