Water Department

The Water Department has been very busy this month working on water leaks, water service inspections, tower project, water sample testing, flushing fire hydrants, water main and service line locating. Verizon and Comcast has completed the installation of cables on RT 5 and the contractor will start work on May 27, 2015, to finish the installation of the Heritage Creek water loop. Completion of this project should be in 3 weeks. The completion of the water tower on Chandler St. is done and I am pleased to say it is back in use. Shipbuilders Tower project is on hold at this time do to a problem with the contractor getting concrete specs. We are working with our engineer and contractor to resolve this issue. The Water Mapping project is going good and we are working hard to locate every water line, service line, street valve and curb valve in town. Shipbuilders Fire Suppression Line is getting closer to completion, with 2 more service lines to repair and to finish the final mapping of the system. I am estimating that this work will be completed in 4 weeks.

Streets Department

The Streets Department has been busy cleaning storm drains, picking up trash of the road, hand sweeping streets and emptying trash receptacles. We've been very busy trying to keep the storm drains cleaned from dirt, sand and trash. We've been busy cold patching roads and so far we have used a total of seven tons of cold patch, as we have had a hard winter that has caused this problem with pot holes. The paving projects on Prettyman, Hazard and Manship are completed. We are edging the three roadways with top soil. We are also spraying weeds on the curb line of streets town wide.

Parks

We've started pulling weeds in the beds, cutting grass, picking up trash and edging in the three parks. We've been picking up the Milton Garden Club's bags and helping them out as needed. We've started to mulch and spray weeds.
