The Chairman of the Water Committee John Bushey called the monthly meeting of the Milton Water Committee meeting to order in the Milton Library, Room 4, 121 Union Street, Milton, De, at 5:00 P.M.

Roll Call was taken with the following members present: John Bushey, Sam Garde, Michael Cote, PD Camenisch, and Dan Wellbourn; Greg Wingo was absent.

Also in attendance were 5 residents of Heritage Creek concerning tap water temperatures.

Approval of Minutes June 8, 2016

Motion made by PD Camenisch and Seconded by Michael Cote to accept prior minutes.

Old Business:

Water rates increase was raised but a discussions was tabled until a future meeting.

A motion was made by PD Camenisch and seconded by Michael Cote that the water rates discussion be removed from the agenda until a future meeting when a discussion would take place regarding the budget for 2017.

Sam Garde brought up a Draft Budget for a discussion but withdrew after Bushey mentioned that addition information was needed.

New Business:

Heritage creek water temperatures were submitted to the committee members which were taken by individual homeowners.

In addition the Dan Wellbourn brought up the fact that a state rep, town maintenance and Dan tested 3 fire hydrates in the community. The testing was conducted as follows:

The person from town maintenance turned individual hydrants on and let then run 5 – 10 minutes each.

The state representative took temperature reading from each and they averaged Between 74 and 78 degrees. Front and Back water sources were tested as part of the

Hydrants checked.

After a discussion which proved inconclusive, John Bushey recommended that a temperature reading be taken from the pipe under the street.

Motion was made by Bushey to request that Greg take temperature reading around town. John Oates from Heritage creek suggested that the schools be tested.

Motion was made by adjournment by John Bushey and seconded by Dan Wellbourn
