ENDORSEMENT OF THE MILTON POLICE DEPARTMENTS PARTICIPATION IN THE DELAWARE POLICE ACCREDITATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Section 29 of the Charter of the Town of Milton provides that, "the Town Council is vested by this Charter with the following powers, to be exercised by the Town Council in the interest of good government, and the safety, health and public welfare of the Town, its inhabitants and affairs"; and

WHEREAS, Section 22 of the Charter of the Town of Milton vests in the Town Council the power and duty to make such rules and regulations as may be necessary for the organization, government and control of the police force, and the police force shall have such duties as the Town Council shall prescribe; and

WHEREAS, the Delaware Police Accreditation Commission was established on May 22, 2008 by the 144th General Assembly, House Bill No. 347, codified in Title 11, Chapter 97 of the Delaware Code; and

WHEREAS, the Town will benefit by the Milton Police Department achieving State accreditation and maintaining its high standards of professionalism; and

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2016, Mayor and Town Council members voted unanimously to approve of Chief Robert Longo submitting an application to the Delaware Police Accreditation Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Milton that Milton Police Department's participation in the Delaware Police Accreditation Program is hereby endorsed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Milton Police Department will maintain all agency responsibilities and standards for active participation in the Delaware Police Accreditation Program.
