Milton Comprehensive Plan to Consider Broadkill River at July 28 Public Meeting

The Town of Milton's Planning and Zoning Commission invites the community to learn about projected Broadkill River water level increases and water quality issues, as part of the town's comprehensive planning process, on Monday, July 28th @ 6:30 pm.

The meeting is part of a nearly year-long planning process that will develop a Comprehensive Plan that will guide the town's development over the next decade.

At the July 28 meeting -- which will take place at Milton Fire Hall, 116 Front Street -- the community will hear a presentation by Susan Love, a Planner with DNREC'S Delaware Coastal Programs. A sea level rise expert, Love will discuss how increases in sea level and precipitation will impact the Broadkill River, adjacent riparian buffers and floodplains, and the town's commercial center. She will also discuss the river's water quality and ways in which it can be improved.
