RESOLUTION 2021-003

TO ESTABLISH AND APPOINT MEMBERS TO A TRAFFIC CALMING ADVISORY AD HOC COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council received traffic-related public comments at the December 7, 2020 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council received and discussed a memorandum on obstructions, careless driving (such as speeding, cell phone use, and not fully stopping at Stop Signs), and large truck traffic on the same date; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council desire the concerns be reviewed and taken under consideration by a committee for an advisory report; and

WHEREAS, Section 15(c) of the Town Charter authorizes the establishment of various committees and working groups;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Milton that:

1. The following members are appointed to a Traffic Calming Advisory Ad Hoc Committee:
 - a) Randi Meredith, Councilwoman, Chairperson
 - b) Bonnie Bloomquist
 - c) Ann Pratt
 - d) Mary Quigley
 - e) Susan Fewell
 - f) Hunter Willis
 - g) Lisa Falzarano
 - h) Chris Trask
 - i) Derrick Harvey, Chief of Police, Ad Hoc Committee Liaison, non-voting member
 - j) Greg Wingo, Public Works Supervisor, Ad Hoc Committee Liaison, non-voting member

2. The designated Chairperson shall facilitate said Committee meetings, which shall comply with the Freedom of Information Act, including notice and minutes requirements, and the

Chairperson may request assistance from Town staff, via the Town Manager, to assist therein.

3. The Committee shall report their findings and recommendation regarding these traffic-related concerns back to Mayor and Council during the scheduled regular Council meeting on July 12, 2021.
4. Said Committee shall sunset on August 30, 2021.
5. Appointed members serve at the pleasure of the Mayor and Town Council.
