RESOLUTION 2022-004
TO FORMALLY ADOPT THE TOWN OF MILTON ADA TRANSITION PLAN:
PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY

WHEREAS, the Town Charter of the Town of Milton, Delaware (“Town”) provides in Section 29, that, the Mayor and Town Council is vested by this Charter with powers, to be exercised by the Town Council in the interest of good government, and the safety, health and public welfare of the Town, its inhabitants and affairs, including to “provide for and preserve the health, peace, safety, cleanliness, ornament, good order and public welfare of the Town and its inhabitants”; and

WHEREAS, the Town Charter also provides in Section 29 that the Mayor and Town Council is authorized to “ascertain, locate, layout, establish, open, change, alter, widen, abandon, regulate the use and enjoyment of, prevent, or remove any obstruction of, level, grade, flag, dress, pave, gravel, shell, improve, dredge, erect, remove, repair or replace any new or present street, highway, lane, alley, water course, park, lake, crosswalk, wharf, dock, sewer, drain, aqueduct, or pipeline or portion thereof, or any new or present sidewalk, curb, or gutter or portion thereof within the Town; to specify the grade thereof, the materials to be used in doing thereof and the manner in which the same shall be done; to enter into contracts or agreements for the doing thereof, including contracts or agreements with the State of Delaware for the permanent maintenance, repair and upkeep of any street, lane, alley, roadway or other public thoroughfare within the Town”; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Americans with Disabilities Act (“ADA”) Transition Plan (“the Plan”) is to create reasonable, accessible paths of travel in the public right of way for everyone; and

WHEREAS, the Town presented its draft ADA Transition Plan on February 7, 2022; and

WHEREAS, a Public Notice was advertised in the Cape Gazette on February 18 requesting public comments and attendance at Council meetings and that it was anticipated Town Council would formally adopt the Plan at its April 4, 2022 meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Milton that during the duly noticed and held Town Council meeting on April 4, 2022, the Town

of Milton ADA Transition Plan: Pedestrian Facilities in the Public Right of way, is hereby adopted and made effective on April 4, 2022.

I, **RICHARD BATY**, Secretary of the Town Council of the Town of Milton, do hereby certify that the above resolution was passed at the meeting of the Town Council, duly called and convened, held on the 4th day of April, 2022, at which a quorum was present and voting throughout and that same is still in full force and effect.
