

Sergeant-(Sgt) Three stripes worn on sleeves- 2 positions in Dept.

Eligible to be appointed after minimum 6 years of police experience if position is available

Corporal-(Cpl.)Two stripes worn on sleeves



Reference: 2023 Budgetary Item Requests

Dear Mayor Collier and Town Councilmembers,

With the presentation of the Police Department's 2023 Budget, I would like to propose five (5) additional items to enhance and develop our police agency. These adjustments are to create structure, stability and efficiency within our ranks, operations, and functionality to our department and to the Town of Milton.

Departmental Promotions

The first proposed request is to the structuring of our ranks with departmental promotions. We have requested four (4) promotions during this budget year. The promotions are outlined below:

a. Corporal Chris Whitehouse has been eligible for promotion to the rank of Sergeant since February 2021.

- b. Officer First Class Michael Guerrieri is eligible for promotion to the rank of Corporal.
- c. Corporal Casey Lewis is eligible for the rank of Sergeant.
- d. Officer First Class Brent Schoof is eligible for the rank of Corporal.

Structuring the department with two (2) Sergeant positions creates a more efficient and systematic organization. This aids with the rank structure as well as the supervision of junior officers. It also helps develop, nurture, and cultivate officers with leadership abilities as well as preparing the department to operate effectively. Promotions create an ability to grow, educate and train our officers to succeed and aid in building the Town of Milton. Nonetheless, with promotions comes additional responsibilities. These promotions will help these officers expand their leadership, knowledge, dedication and drive while building the junior officers as well as building our department, the town and the Milton community.

Officer Funding

The second proposed request is the funding of the eleventh (11) Police Officer.

a. Requesting one additional officer position to continue to prepare for the growth we currently have in progress: effective in the Spring 2023.

According to worldpopulationreview.com (Milton, Delaware Population 2022 (Demographics, Maps, Graphs) (worldpopulationreview.com)

Milton has a 2020 population of **3,189**. Milton is currently growing at a rate of 1.88% annually and its population has increased by 24.09% since the most recent census, which recorded a population of **2,570** in 2010.

The average household income in Milton is \$88,492 with a poverty rate of 10.46%. The median rental costs in recent years comes to \$841 per month, and the median house value is \$301,800. The median age in Milton is 47.4 years, 47.3 years for males, and 47.4 years for females.

The recent annexation of 450 acres of land on Sand Hill Road (The Granary at Draper Farm) is proposed to have 1,350 units. This project has not broken ground as of yet, however, it is scheduled for the summer 2023.

The Milton Attainable Housing project located on Route 16 (Milton-Ellendale Highway and Bay Road) has already broken ground and construction is forthgoing. This project is scheduled to have four (4) commercial sites and 239 residential units. This project has also proposed a dog park, swimming pool and a clubhouse.

The recent annexation of 50 acres on Harbeson Road (Scarlet Oaks) is proposed to have 163 units. This project has not broken ground as of yet.

I am humbly requesting your assistance with these five (5) additional items to the 2023 Budget. I respectfully thank you for your time and consideration in this additional proposal.
