### ABSENTEE BALLOTS

A registered voter that is unable to come to the election polls on the day of the election must complete an affidavit prior to receiving an absentee ballot. The completed affidavit must be received in Town Hall by noon on Friday, March 4, 2022.

Absentee ballots can be mailed to registered voters, who have completed an affidavit through February 25, 2022. If the registered voter needs the ballot after February 25, 2022, they must come to Town Hall and pick up the ballot. All absentee ballots must be received by the Board of Elections by the close of the election polls at 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 5, 2022.

### **SNOW REMINDER FROM THE DESK OF THE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER...**

- \* Snowfall exceeding 2 inches must be removed from the sidewalks within 24 hours after the snow ceases to fall. (Chapter 183-54 of the Town Code)
- \* Do not shovel snow from the sidewalks into the street. (Chapter 183-55 of the Town Code)
- \* If possible, do not park on the street during snowfall so that snowplows can easily navigate to clear the streets.
