RESOLUTION 2023-020

TO REQUEST THAT DELDOT INSTALL A FOLDABLE "WATER ON ROADWAY" SIGN FOR USE BY TOWN STAFF

WHEREAS, the Charter of the Town of Milton vests power in the Mayor and Town Council to provide for and preserve the health, peace, safety, cleanliness, ornament, good order and public welfare of the Town and its inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, when there is flooding on Front Street and Union Street, road closure signage for flooding is currently placed within town limits.

WHEREAS, drivers head into town from Cave Neck Road to Front Street and at that point drivers discover that they cannot proceed and must reroute. For larger truck traffic there is nowhere to turn around. Freight vehicle drivers then enter streets that are too narrow to accommodate their truck size. These streets include, but are not limited to: Collins Street, Walnut Street, and Mill Street.; and

WHEREAS, Cave Neck Road is a DelDOT maintained roadway where flood signage would be most readily viewed by drivers, at a point where they could reroute.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Town Council of Milton hereby respectfully request that the Delaware Department of Transportation install a foldable "Water on Roadway" sign with permanent posts on Cave Neck Road near Front Street that would be activated (folded/unfolded) by Town of Milton staff when flood conditions are present.

Signage is to be compliant with the (DE MUTCD) Delaware Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
